2014 Pinot Noir

**90 points from Wine Spectator**

**Aroma:** Berry aromas with subtle spice.

**Palate:** Fruit-driven; rich with cherry, plum, and red and dark berry flavors. Smooth, light tannins and excellent structure and balance.

## Winemaker's Comments:

This was another easy vintage: Very dry and cool. Flavors were superb, as was fruit condition. The fruit was picked, sorted, and plunged by hand. The wine is made in a food-friendly Old World-style.
